



Maternal Support Practitioner Full vs. Partial Scholarship

To support more individuals in the community, we have updated the process for being awarded a partial OR full scholarship. This will allow you to self identify what level of support you will require to access the program.

This will allow us to support more folks with exactly what they need. We have a limited number of full scholarships available and we have opened up with significantly more partial scholarships.

We are asking that you select the option that will remove the barriers for you to attend. You may just need a little bit of support, leaving the full scholarships for folks needing more support. This will increase the likelihood of everyone receiving the scholarships they need!

Please keep in mind that we have experienced and highly-skilled instructors and facilitators and we pay them a living wage. This is a high-touch program made with love ♥

We have awarded over **300** partial scholarships and over **60** full scholarships over the last 7 years.

WHAT'S THE DIFFERENCE?

The full scholarship offer has limited availability and is reserved for those who need it.

Partial scholarships keep the full scholarship spaces open for queer, trans, Black, Indigenous, & people of color experiencing extreme financial hardships.

HERE IS HOW TO SELECT THE SCHOLARSHIP YOU SHOULD APPLY FOR:

100% - Who this is for: This scholarship is open for those in significant debt, who struggle to meet their basic needs like food, housing, child care, health care, and are living paycheck to paycheck. This option will be appropriate for folks who have recently experienced a change in income or sustainability due to war, natural disasters, are housed in a shelter due to domestic violence or trauma, or the recent death of a spouse or child to name a few. This option is for folks who wouldn't be able to join the program without a full scholarship.

50% OR 70% - Who this is for: This scholarship is open for those who may be in some debt (like credit card, medical, mortgage, or student loan), who can mostly meet their basic needs like food, housing, child care, health care, who may still be living paycheck to paycheck. This is also a good option for folks living in countries with a currency conversion to USD making it cost prohibitive like the Philippines, Peru or India and many others.

30% - Who this is for: This partial scholarship is for you if you have a low double income household, or 1 high-income earner, or upward mobility and you can afford this rate without significant sacrifice or hardship. You are just needing a bit more support to access education as you may be struggling with some debt repayment or similar situations.

All students will receive the same program filled with support and care, and will prepare you in launching your business or movement!
